

# UNIVERSAL'S VOLCANO BAY

## SIGNATURE ATTRACTIONS

### THE VOLCANO

#### 1 Krakatau Aqua Coaster (kra-kuh-TAU)

Four-person coaster sends riders upward and down as they twist and turn through the heart of the volcano.

#### 2 Ko'okiri Body Plunge (koh-OH-kee-ree)

Brave a 70-degree fall through a trap door before plunging 125 feet to the waters below.

#### 3 Kala & Tai Nui Serpentine Body Slides (KAH-lah & tie NOO-ee)

From atop the volcano, twin trap doors simultaneously plunge two guests down clear, intertwining tubes.

#### 4 Punga Racers (PUHN-ga)

Single riders on manta ray mats slide down four lanes through underwater sea caves.

### WAVE VILLAGE

#### 5 Waturi Beach (wah-TOO-ree)

Swim, splash and relax in the sparkling waters of this magnificent wave pool at the foot of the mighty Krakatau volcano.

### RAINFOREST VILLAGE

#### 6 Ohyah & Ohno Drop Slides

Plummet down the twisting waters of the Ohyah Slide and drop out four feet above the pool below, or take on the Ohno Slide which launches you six feet above the water.

#### 7 TeAwa The Fearless River (tay-AH-wha)

Hang on tight as you ride your inner tube through the churning whitewater rapids.

#### 8 Maku Puihi Round Raft Rides (mah-KOO poo-EE-hee)

Choose your six-person raft adventure: Maku slides wildly around bowl-like formations, while Puihi gives you the stomach-flipping thrill of zero-gravity hang time.

#### 9 Taniwha Tubes (tah-KNEE-wah)

Riders can try all four twisting tracks while being sprayed by jets of water from mischievous tiki statues.



### RIVER VILLAGE

#### 10 Runamukka Reef (ruhn-UH-muhk-kuh)

This children's play area features bubbling geysers, water blasters, slides and dump cups.

#### 11 Tot Tiki Reef

Toddlers can play among splashy slides, a tot-sized water volcano and a family of friendly tikis with spraying fountains.

#### 12 Kopiko Wai Winding River (koh-pee-KOH why)

Take a leisurely ride through the tropical landscape and encounter plenty of watery surprises along the way.

#### 13 Honu ika Moana (HOH-noo eek-AH mo-AH-na)

Enjoy two twisting, turning, multi-person slides: Honu (the turtle) sweeps up two massive walls, while ika Moana (the whale) sprays riders from the center of the raft.

When guests arrive to Volcano Bay, they'll receive a waterproof TapuTapu wearable for the day. Guests will use their TapuTapu wearable to virtually wait in line for rides while enjoying other areas of the park, enjoy many Tapu Play experiences throughout the park, make cashless purchases and more.

### FEATURED ATTRACTIONS

More than 18 unique attractions, including:

- **Krakatau Aqua Coaster** (kra-kuh-TAU)  
Four-person canoes slide upward through the mists and into the dark twists and turns within the volcano before emerging with a plunge through a shimmering waterfall.
- **Ko'okiri Body Plunge** (koh-OH-kee-ree)  
Join in the tradition of honoring the volcano god, Vol, by braving the incredible Ko'okiri Body Plunge. Featuring a 70-degree fall through a trap door and 125 feet of white-knuckle fun, this descent ends with a watery tribute from Vol himself.
- **Kala & Tai Nui Serpentine Body Slides** (KAH-lah & tie NOO-ee)  
Take a leap of faith from atop the volcano where sea and sky meet. Trap doors plunge two guests down clear, intertwining tubes before sending them joyfully splashing into the turquoise waters below.
- **Waturi Beach** (wah-TOO-ree)  
Swim, splash and relax in the sparkling waters and warm waves of the lagoon at the foot of mighty Krakatau.
- **Ohyah & Ohno Drop Slides**  
Ascend the side of a cliff before plummeting down the twisting waters of the Ohyah Slide and dropping out four feet above the pool below. Then, brave the rope bridge and take the plunge down the Ohno Slide, a serpentine adventure that ends six feet above the awaiting pool.
- **TeAwa The Fearless River** (tay-AH-wha)  
Race along a roaring, watery stream of churning rapids and choppy waves while hanging tight to your inner tube on this thrilling whitewater ride.
- **Maku Puihi Round Raft Rides** (mah-KOO poo-EE-hee)  
Maku slides through a deep volcanic gorge before spinning wildly around bowl-like formations. Then ride Puihi, where you'll feel the stomach-flipping thrill of zero-gravity hang time before splashing your way to safety at the bottom.

- **Kopiko Wai Winding River** (koh-pee-KOH why)  
Take a slow ride on the Kopiko Wai Winding River through a tropical landscape full of surprises. Sprays of water surprise along the way, and beneath the lava rocks, Stargazer's Cavern reveals the magical night sky above.
- **Honu Ika Moana** (HOH-noo eek-AH mo-AH-na)  
Guests can enjoy these two twisting, turning, multi-person slides. Honu (the turtle) sweeps up two massive walls, while Ika Moana (the whale) sprays water on riders from the center of the raft.
